- Allowing Animal Control and Police Officers access to a dog owner's information 24 hours a day, 365 days a year—when your vet clinic may be closed.

- Letting owners locate and identify their lost dogs faster, meaning less kennel fees for dogs that are picked up.

- Locating the owners of an injured animal quickly.

- Providing important information in case of emergencies such as house fires, break-ins, or dog bites.

Dog licensing protects communities by:

- Verifying that all dogs are properly vaccinated, as required by city ordinance.

- Getting critical health information to dog bite victims.

- Limiting the number of days animals are impounded.

- Providing funding for animal control services.
