In light of the COVID-19 pandemic the Owner will ONLY be accepting online electronic bids. Bids for Storm Water and Water Quality Ponds EP-4 and LP-40: Sediment Removal and Outlet Improvements in Eagan, Minnesota will be received by the Owner via QuestCDN VirtuBid (vBid) until **10:30 a.m., CST, Wednesday, February 24th, 2021** opened privately, and then results will be available on QuestCDN.

The Work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, skills, and performing all operations required to construct the Work. The Work is the routine maintenance of stormwater ponds including sediment removal and placement of riprap. The work includes mobilization and demobilization; installing erosion and sediment control BMPs; clearing and grubbing; dewatering and control of water; 550 Tons of MPCA regulated sediment removal and disposal; 56 Tons of Riprap, various sizes; all as provided for in the bidding documents. All quantities and work items in this advertisement for bid are approximate and not guaranteed.

There will be no pre-bid meeting. The Notice to Proceed is expected to be issued on or around **March 16th, 2021**. Work shall commence anytime following the Notice to Proceed and shall be complete and ready for final payment no later than **June 30th, 2021**. Further, for each of the ponds, once construction has begun at a particular pond, Unless otherwise approved by Engineer, Contractor shall have no more than **10 working days** to complete the work in that pond, with the exception of final restoration.

No money will be refunded to any person who obtains plans and specifications. Partial sets of documents will not be issued.

Each bid proposal shall be accompanied by a bidder's bond naming the City of Eagan as obligee; a certified check payable to the Clerk of the City of Eagan; or a cash deposit equal to at least five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid, which shall be forfeited to the City in the event that the bidder fails to enter into a contract. The City Council reserves the right to retain the deposits of the three lowest bidders for a period not to exceed forty-five (45) days after the date and time set for the opening of the bids. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of forty-five (45) days after the date and time set for the opening of bids. Payment for the work will be by cash or check.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and technical proposals, to waive irregularities and informalities therein and further reserves the right to award the contract to the best interests of the City.
